All students in Grades 3-10 will take the Florida Assessment of Student Thinking (FAST) Progress Monitoring (PM) exams three times each year. PM1 & PM2 will be administered remotely. PM3 exams will be administered in person.

- Students are recommended to use 2 devices, one for Zoom and another one for the FL Secure Browser
- o Launch FL Secure Browser
- Follow Test Administrator instructions
- Students will login to the FL Secure Browser with:
 - Username- Individual e-mail sent to guardians and students
 - First name- Legal name as stated on school records
 - Session ID- Test Administrator will provide to students on the day of the exam
- Username will be e-mailed directly to Parent/Guardian

• After Test Date:

- The results for FAST and B.E.S.T. EOC are available in the Family Portal. You can access your student's FAST and B.E.S.T. EOC results in the portal using login information provided by your student's school. You will need your student's six-digit access code (provided by the school), date of birth, and first name, as it appears on school records. You will be able to see and print your student's scale score, achievement level, and a bar graph indicating the student's scale score and where it falls in the achievement level.
- Student Access Code will remain the same from last year (2022/2023)
 - Access Codes will be sent individually to parents and students after each Progress Monitoring testing window finishes.
